A variety of stalls will also be available, offering information about a wide range of activities and volunteering opportunities. There will also be cookery tips and a practical work demonstration by Frome Men's Shed. Customers can also bring along unwanted household items and donate them to Twice as Nice, Aster Communities' furniture, white goods and paint re-use scheme.

Free refreshments will be available throughout the afternoon and baguettes and baked potatoes will be served from 4.00pm. Visitors will be able to enter

free prize draws to win some great items. There will also be a range of children's activities, including Easter-themed crafts and a toy library.
